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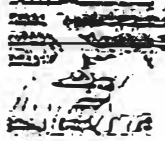
## CATS

## Inaugurations



SOME INAUGURATIONS HAVE SET PRECEDENTS, OTHERS HAVE BEEN MARKED BY FOUL-UPS, UNUSUAL INCIDENTS AND BAD WEATHER. HERE ARE A FEW EXAMPLES.

GEORGE WASHINGTON WAS SUPPOSED TO BE INAUGURATED MARCH 4, BUT DID NOT TAKE THE OATH UNTIL APRIL 30. BAD WEATHER DELAYED COUNTING OF THE VOTE AND IT TOOK WASHINGTON 2 WEEKS TO TRAVEL BY HORSE TO NEW YORK BECAUSE OF THE ENTHUSIASTIC CROWDS HE ENCOUNTERED ON THE WAY.

AFTER HIS INAUGURATION IN 1853, FRANKLIN PIERCE RETURNED TO THE WHITE HOUSE AT NIGHT TO FIND NO SERVANTS OR SLEEPING QUARTERS. HE SLEPT ALONE IN THE MANSION ON A MATTRESS.

RUTHERFORD HAYES' WIFE LUCY DEFIED VICTORIAN TRADITION AT HER HUSBAND'S INAUGURATION IN 1877 TO WEAR AN OUTFIT THAT JOURNALISTS LABELED 'MADONNA CHIC.' SHE WAS ALSO THE FIRST TO BE CALLED THE 'FIRST LADY.'

IN 1981, SOME PERSONS WHO HAD PAID \$2,000 FOR BOX SEATS AT RONALD REAGAN'S INAUGURAL BALL WERE LOCKED OUT BY DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA FIRE MARSHALS, WHO SAID THE HALLS WERE TOO CROWDED.

(DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION) SAID THEY NEEDED TO IMPROVE THE PALMETTO EXPRESSWAY. THE DOT IS NEGOTIATING TO BUY THE FLEA MARKET WHICH IS AT 7751 BIRD ROAD. 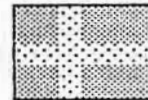

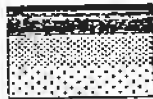
