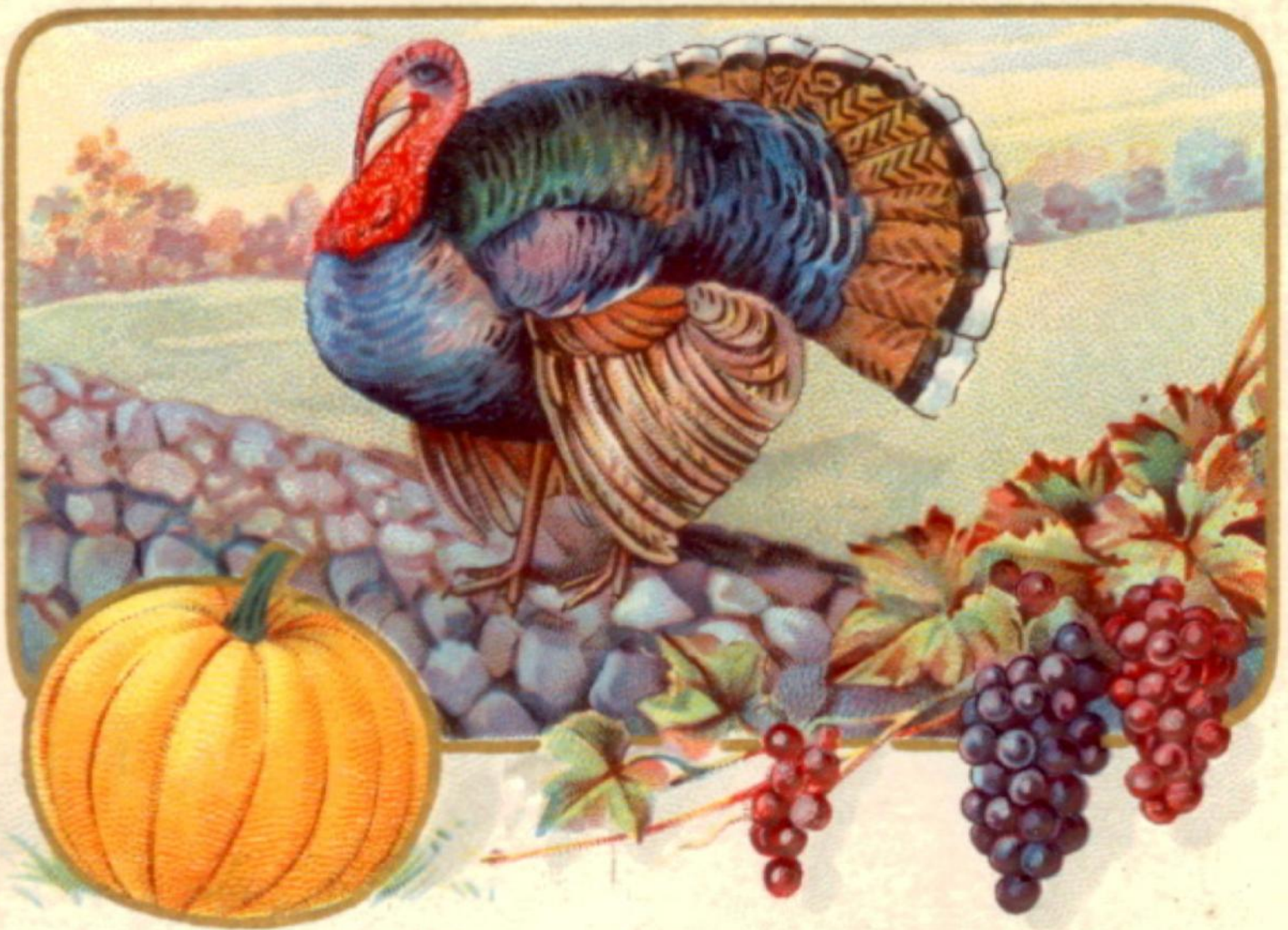

# Candid Comments from the Producer



## Happy Thanksgiving!

We are at the end of November and celebrating Thanksgiving. So, Happy Thanksgiving!

A lot has happened over the past few weeks! I finished up work in Leadville then rented a truck to move my stuff on Tuesday, November 3 to Colorado Springs with dad getting and driving the truck. It was a large, black 2015 Dodge that drove very smoothly! The next day, Wednesday, November 4, we returned the truck and rented a car and drove to Lubbock. I needed to take care of some details there before I moved there. We got back to the Springs on Saturday, November 7. Over the next few days, I packed up my stuff and piled it in the garage. On Thursday, November 12, I picked up the moving truck from U-Haul and packed everything that afternoon and evening. It took a few hours into the early evening. I left on Friday and drove to Lubbock. It was the first time I ever drove that size of vehicle. Fortunately, it was very smooth and the drive went without issue. I took the plains route from the Springs to Pueblo to Lamar to Boise City to Amarillo to Lubbock. I did not want to spend any more than necessary on gas by taking the

mountain route, especially with a truck that had 10 mpg! I arrived that evening. My plan was to get to Lubbock and take the weekend to unload into my apartment. However, I found out on Thursday that the apartment fell through, so I had to start over my search. It took a little while, but I finally signed a lease at my old apartment from the late 2000s, Canyon Crossing apartments. I lived there the first time from 2006 through 2010.

I started my new job on Monday, November 16. I am currently in a trial like period, as is common with many jobs.

*"I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving."*

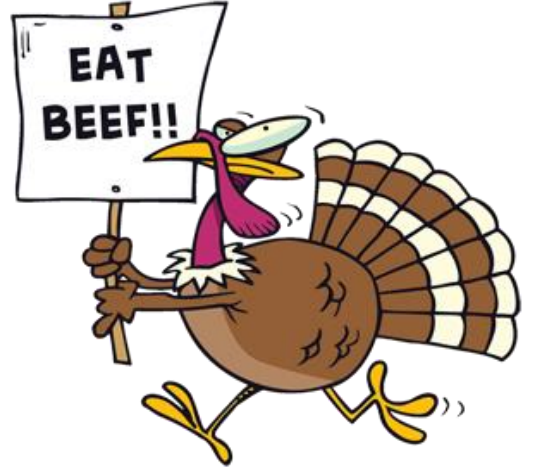

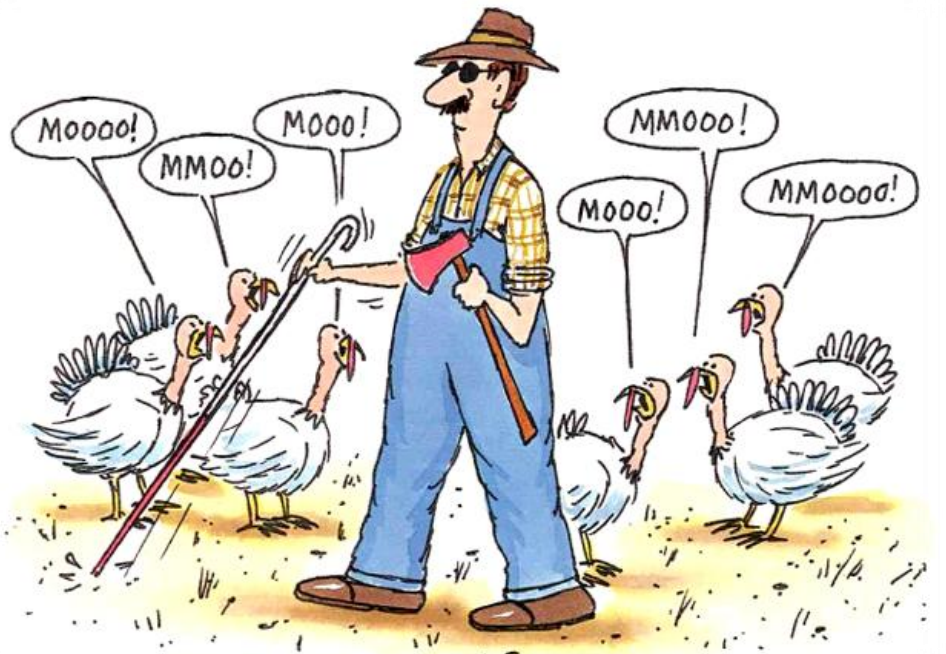
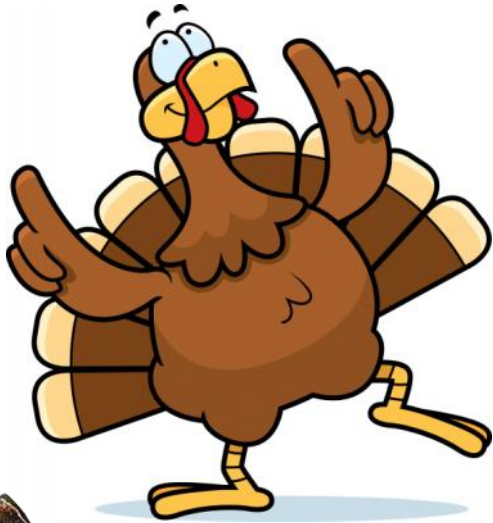
